In CTWSI's Conference Room in the Watertown Location, at 9:00 AM Central Time Zone on August 13, 2026, proposals will be opened publicly and read aloud. Proposal shall not be withdrawn by any proposer for a period of 60 calendar days after opening proposals. CTWSI will review the proposals as prescribed in the RFP as the process of selecting a vendor. CTWSI reserves the right to reject all proposals; to accept proposals it deems to be in its best interest and to waive any or all informalities in proposing procedures.
