Revolutionary Perspective

- Kings George II and III issued general warrants
- Allowed indiscriminate searches of colonists
- Americans revolted
- General warrants and widespread searches were vanquished
- Widespread searches are back
- Part of a multi-decade erosion of democracy

Our American Constitution

Amendment IV

"<u>The right of the people to be secure</u> in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, <u>shall not be violated</u>, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized."

TSA Legal Basis

- No general warrant (they're obsolete)
- No specific search warrants
- Unconstitutional laws require travelers' "consent" to search without suspicion so they can fly
- Real basis is government power to arrest

TSA Searches

- Start with detailed whole body scan
- Sometimes followed by localized patdown unwarranted physical intrusion
- Sometimes followed by full body patdown sexual assault
- Sexual assault is a crime

Preventing Patdowns

- If poor, stay home or take a bus
- If moderate income, drive
- If rich, private jet
- If brave, wear a bikini

Bikini Response

- OK in Sioux Falls sweet!
- Major conniption in some cities
- No response from airport police to:

- What is the law on indecent exposure?
- Police don't know law and don't care
- Police protect power, not people
- Security is not the goal; invading space is

Bikini Response Continued

- Expect to be surrounded by intimidating police
- Police in your face "poking the bear"
