Dear Families,

The children have done a wonderful job of settling into the routine of school. We have so many fun activities for the month of October. Please use this newsletter as a reference for the whole month. Attached are flyers for additional information.

Question of the Month: Each month the Pre-K will be asked to learn an answer to an important question in an effort to better prepare them for kindergarten. The question for October is "What is your first and last name?" The teachers will be testing the children throughout the month. Please emphasize just their first name and just their last name. Sometimes children run their first, middle, and last name all together, but don't really know the difference.
