If you are new to CASA, we recruit and train volunteers who advocate for abused and neglected children removed from their homes across nine counties: Aurora, Brule, Buffalo, Charles Mix, Davison, Douglas, Hanson, Hutchinson, and McCook.

Our goal is simple yet profound: to help children find safe, permanent homes. When it is possible, this means supporting families as they overcome their challenges and reunite with their children.

I have been with CASA since 2011, and every day I am inspired by the stories I witness. Volunteers stand beside children and families in their most difficult moments, ensuring a child's voice is heard in court. Our staff work tirelessly behind the scenes, building connections and creating brighter futures. In June, during National Reunification Month, we celebrated victories like these — families reunited, second chances embraced, and futures reshaped.

However, the truth is that <u>we cannot do this work alone</u>. We need your help as a volunteer or supporter to ensure every child has someone standing by their side. Together, we can recruit and train more volunteers, help a child feel safe and seen, and support families as they overcome challenges and reunite stronger than ever.
