Dear Families,

The children have done a wonderful job of adjusting to the school routine. We have a variety of fun activities planned for the month of October. Please use this newsletter as a reference for the whole month. Attached are flyers for additional information.

Question of the Month: Each month, the Pre-K will be asked to learn an answer to an important question in an effort to better prepare them for kindergarten. The question for October is "What is your first and last name?" The teachers will be testing the children throughout the month. Please emphasize just their first name and just their last name. Sometimes children run their first, middle, and last name all together, but don't really know the difference.

Work Samples: Some of the activities your child completes in the Pre-K class will not be sent home. Teachers will be keeping some work samples to share at the conference.

Letters: Please take the time to reinforce identifying the upper and lowercase letters we have learned so far. In addition, play games to teach your child about the sound of each letter. This can be done in many fun and physical ways that promote early literacy skills.

Mystery Reader: We still have an opening for October 21st. Our mystery reader will prepare a short story to read to the class on the assigned day at 2:20 pm. We

ask that you wait in the hall until we are ready for your surprise visit! The children will be so excited. Thank you!

Diwali: In Pre-K, we love to learn about holidays celebrated around the world. On Monday, October 20th, our class will learn about Diwali. This is a holiday known as the "Festival of Lights," which marks the start of the Hindu New Year. As in many holidays, everyone wears their nicest clothes, so please dress up as we learn about an important holiday of our peers!

October 28th - Show-n-Tell: The children are asked to bring in one part or piece of their Halloween costume. The other children will try to guess what they will be.


