Council Updates

Liaisons – We currently have 34 churches with confirmed liaisons. Joe is working on ways to best reach out to congregations to find VDC church liaisons. Ideas to help with this:

a) Send letters to churches that do not have a named liaison.

b) Send a letter to ten 4th day persons from a designated church requesting their assistance or suggestions in filling the liaison need at their church. (Using this method with ten different churches would offer a connection of 100 people.)

c) Find a list of rectors from season's past asking if they would act as a liaison for their church.

d) Ask VDC Council members to be a liaison at their church

Trailer Supplies – Pete asked the 4 team rectors of the Feb weekends to write a list of what was in each of their bins before reloading the trailer. Brian received one response. Pete and Brian will examine items in the trailer and take inventory of all items prior to the upcoming August weekend.

Site selection – Pitching new churches is a delicate process that takes time. Gustavus Adolphus was suggested by a 4th day person. At one time they had a large VDC community. Jonathan is in contact with them. He has also tried to contact Trinity, Discover and Faith. Anyone who would like to help with this, please reach out to Jonathan.

Ultreya – Brian related that an ultreya is under consideration prior to the Marty's August ultreya. A number of folks from Bethlehem Lutheran in the Midway have recently gone through VDC. Wayne spoke with their liaison, Mary Amdahl, about a possible May or June ultreya at their church. Their church is not available until after 6:00 PM so we could possibly have a 2 hour gathering instead of 3 hours.
