Self-Addressed Envelope: We ask that each child bring a self-addressed business-size envelope. The envelope can be made out to "The (your last name) Family". Please talk with your child about what is their address and last name. Finish writing your address on the envelope and attach an envelope. Then, to tie in our theme or community helpers, we will talk about the role of a mailperson. Please hand in these envelopes to the green tray by Friday, February 6th, please.

Valentine's Party February 14th: Each child is asked to bring in 20 Valentine's with their name on the Valentine's to pass out to their friends. Please DO NOT put friends' names on them. Just have your child write their name only on the Valentine, please. It is usually best to have them write their name on a few valentines a night until they reach 20. **Please place the valentines in a bag, labeled with their name**, and place it on the cart the afternoon of the party. The children can also wear red, white, or pink. We are also seeking families to contribute treats for our party. [PreK Valentine Sign Up](#)

Show-n-Tell on Tuesday, February 17th: Please have your child bring in an instrument that they will use for the parade. This can even be a homemade instrument. The students will talk about what instrument they brought, who gave it to them, or how they made it.

Parade on Tuesday, February 17th: The children will be having a Patriotic Parade on Tuesday, February 17th. **The children are asked to wear red, white, and blue to school on that day.** Families are invited to attend. The parade will take place at 2:30. Dismissal will immediately follow.

Question of the Month: What is your address? This is an important question that will take some time to master, so please start practicing.

100th Day Celebration, February 19th: (Tentative) We are planning on having a big celebration for our 100th day of PreK. Children are to bring in 100 items that will fit in a gallon-sized Ziplock bag. Students will share with their peers what their collection is and why they chose it.


