



## Two's First Day Checklist

### What FBC Child Development Provides:

<b>Cot Sheets</b>	Cot sheets are changed, washed and provided weekly for your toddlers when they are in our care. You will be responsible for providing a blanket weekly. Blankets will be stored on cots and on Friday will be placed in the cubby to go home to be washed and return on Monday.
<b>Naptime</b>	Naptime for the school ranges from 12pm-2:30pm. We ask that children are not dropped off during that time so we don't interrupt rest time for the students in the classrooms.
<b>Meals</b>	Our School provides 3 meals a day. Breakfast, Lunch, and Snack. Menus will always be posted on the parent board at the entrance.
<b>Meal Serving Times</b>	Breakfast 8:30am-9:45am    Lunch 11:30am-1:00pm    Snack: 2:15pm-4:00pm Please check your child's schedule for their classroom eating time.
<b>Daily Activity Report</b>	We will provide you with a Daily Activity Report through our parent engagement app, telling you about your baby's day.
<b>Potty Training</b>	We are here to help assist with this milestone by creating a consistent and pressure free environment. Once this process is ready to begin at the school the teachers will have a meeting with you. As a reminder, you need to be prepared to send at least 4 outfits a day.

### Important Reminder:



**Complete Required Forms:** You may have submitted these forms in advance. If not, the following forms are needed on the first day:

- Feeding Form
- USDA Application
- Shot Record
- Medical Report
- Medication Form (if applicable).

## What to pack for your Toddler:

<b>Diapers</b>	We request that you bring diapers in bulk for your child's first day and we will alert you when it is time to replenish their supply. It is better to have too many than not enough, so we suggest 8-10 per day.	
<b>Wipes</b>	Pack a full container initially and bring a refill package and we will follow-up to replenish them as needed when they run out.	
<b>Clothing</b>	Send your child with two or three outfits initially, sealed and labeled in a bag. We will send home any soiled clothes to be replaced as needed. Include socks in addition to different weather appropriate clothing. Your child will be spending time both indoors and outdoors, so they'll need to be comfortable all day. *Please remember they will get dirty*	
<b>Handwashing upon Arrival</b>	When your two year old come to school in the mornings, they will be directed to wash their hands. If you choose to help wash their hands you will need to the sink by the window in the classroom. The handsink by the entry door is for pottying only.	
<b>Shoes</b>	Each day, bring your toddler in hard bottom closed toe shoes. They must have secure shoes on at all times. Sandals are allowed but the toes must be covered.	
<b>Diaper Rash Cream &amp; Ointment</b>	If you are providing rash cream for your child, you must fill out a medication form provided by CDC and store the labeled cream in a sealable bag still in original container..	

## Bags and Outside Food Reminder:

### **Bags:**

We do not allow bags in the classrooms. All items must be unpacked and should fit in their cubbies.

If you need to leave a bag please let the teacher know and you can lock it away in the lounge. The key will always be hanging on the door. Place on shelf that states "Diaper Bags"

### **Outside Food:**

Outside food is not allowed. You must throw it away upon arrival . That includes drinks from home. We will not be able to store the cup in the classroom.
