SICK POLICY: We ask that you please keep in mind that our sick policy is that a child must be free of fever, vomiting, or diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school. We ask that you do not give your child fever-reducing medicine to mask the symptoms. Please understand that a fever is a precursor to contagious colds, Covid, and Monkeypox. We appreciate your diligence in avoiding the spread of illness.

NEWSLETTERS: Each month your teachers will provide you with details about activities in your child's classroom. These newsletters will be emailed to your family, and posted on the class bulletin board, and our school website. If you are not receiving an email with our monthly newsletters please let Ms. Cindy know and she will resolve the issue.

DROP OFF & PICK UP: Since we have limited time with our students we ask that you are on time for your child to start their school day. Please wait in the hallway with your child until the teacher opens the door to greet them. At the end of the day, the teacher will want to share with you about your child's day, so **please arrive 10 minutes before dismissal.** We ask that you please keep all children by your side in the hall. Please avoid them playing on the stairs, in the fellowship hall, or the gym. If for any reason you need us to bring your child out to the car (perhaps younger siblings are sleeping) please just call the office and we are happy to accommodate.

Paperwork: Just a reminder that all paperwork is due by Friday, September 13th. Please understand that we cannot allow your child to attend school past this date if their medical form is not on file, so please don't delay!
