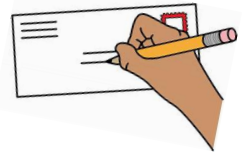

March 20th	Art Show



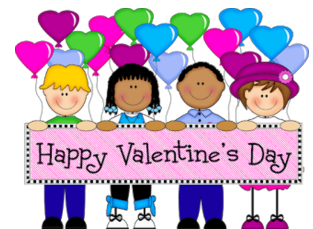

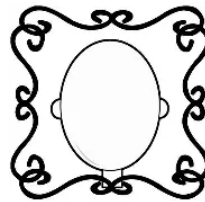
